This guide is tested with Regisafe Version 4.6 and the Silent Brick WORM Archive Version 2.10

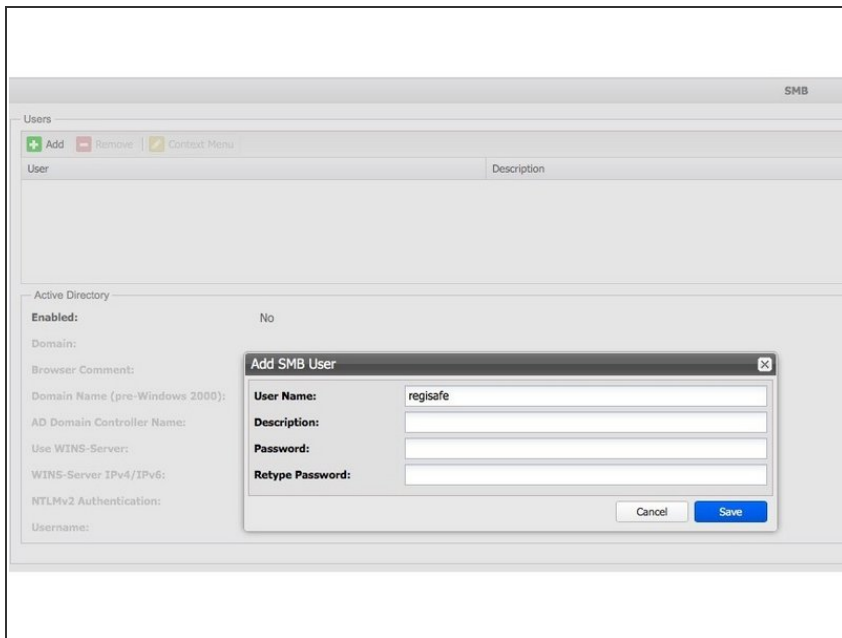
## Step 1 — General Information

 **Requirements** Compliance Option is necessary to enable various WORM volume types.

 **Installation and Connectors** Installation and electrical connection as well as network connection are to be done as described in the manual Installation

 **Network Adjustments** The network settings are to be adjusted as described in the manual Installation

## Step 2 — User settings



- Connect to the Silent Brick Web Interface
- Switch to Settings -> SMB
- Create a user 'regisafe' with a proper password

## Step 3 — Volume Settings

- Create an archive including WORM and Stage Brick
- Create a sub-volume of type WORM with Retention (RWRO triggered).
- The retention period in years and days must be adopted to the value necessary for the data content being archived

- Case Sensitive might be switched on, as long as no problems are detected. In case errors occur

during data retrieval this switch should be switched off.

- Make sure to search for the service user you entered before and add it to the list of users granted access (**regisafe** in this sample configuration)

## Step 5 — Connect regisafe

- For the use of a Silent Brick as archive medium it is absolutely necessary to set **NAS Worm** as an option
- The Worm medium must be specified as file target in the Server.ini and Client.ini
- The name of the medium can be chosen freely, here FastLTASilentBrick
- Make sure to enable 'Versionsprüfung'
