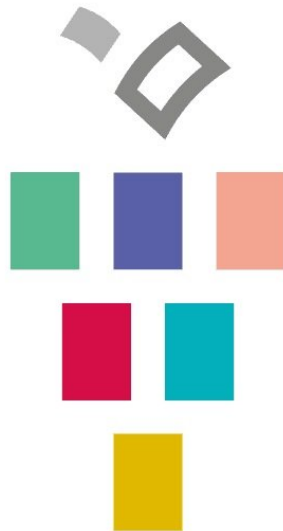

INTRODUCTION

This manual describes the connection setup between FAST LTA Silent Brick System Version 2.15.0.9 and LCS Computer Service GmbH WINYARD DMS in Version 1.19.0222.0

Step 1 — General information

⚠ Requirements Compliance Option is necessary to enable various WORM volume types.

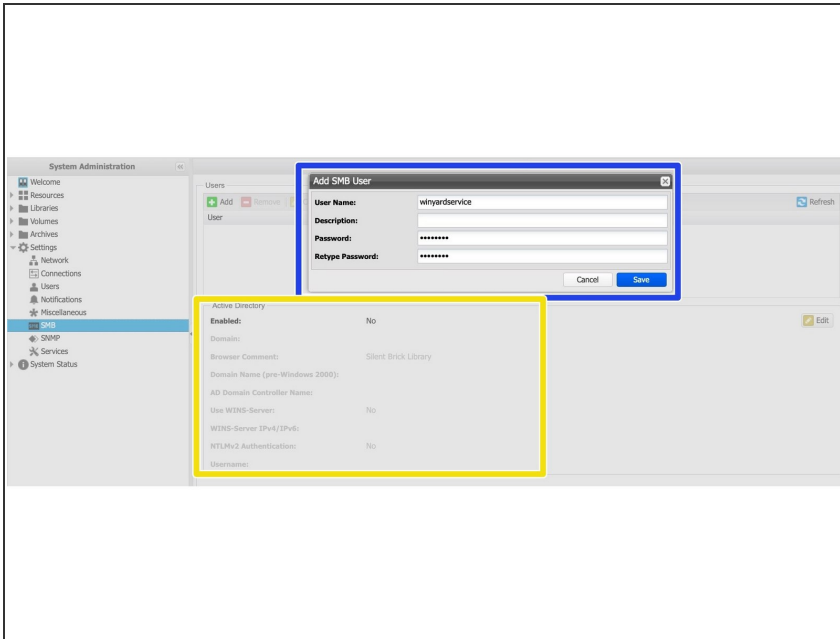
- i Installation and Connectors** Installation and electrical connection as well as network connection are to be done as described in the manual Installation
- i Network Adjustments** The network settings are to be adjusted as described in the manual Installation
- i Archive Creation** Prior to the setup an archive has to be created consisting of WORM and Stage Bricks

Step 2 — Volume settings

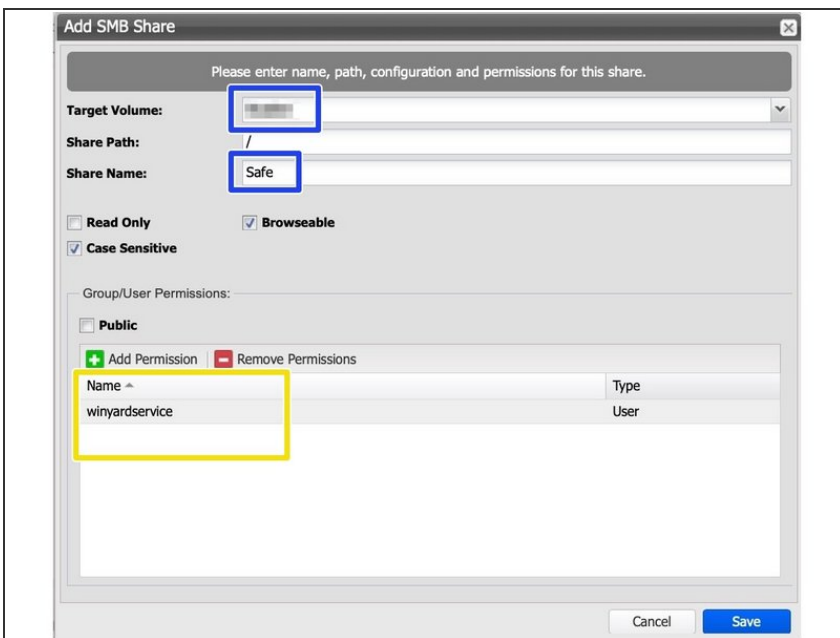
- i WINYARD DMS** utilizes two different volumes and supports retention as well as safe files
 - Safe: Single File Archive
 - Archive: Package / Project Archive
 - Create two Volumes "Archive" and "Safe"
 - Volume Type "WORM with Retention and Versioning (RWRO trigger)". Retention period may be set to 1 day.
 - Retention Period may be set to 1 day. Will be set per file by WINYARD DMS.
 - Safe Files enabled in XML
 - No 0-byte archival

Step 3 — Create user



- ❗ WINYARD DMS uses a dedicated user for the communication to the Network share. The user may be
 - ❗ A local user
 - ❗ An active directory user
- Depending on the type
 - create a new local user under settings >> users
 - or join the active directory

Step 4 — Share settings



- Create on share for each of the two volumes
- Naming should be "Safe" and "Archive" as for the volume
- Make sure to choose the correct user for WINYARD DMS

Step 5 — Set up WINYARD DMS
